Notes:

General Education Sequence (32 cr.). Communication Arts and Literature students must complete the general education requirements and should do so in the following manner. (See General Education Requirements for explanation of double counting and waivers.)

Core: Complete all courses (16 cr.)

Area A: Waive or double count one ENGL (3 cr.) from the left column. (Diversity options are ENGL 203 or 215 or 216).

Waive one CMST (3 cr.) from the left column.

Take IM 260 (3 cr.). Test out possible. If test out passed, take COMM 220 on right side.

Area B: Take two courses from the left column; one must be a lab course (6 credits). Diversity option: BIO 106.

Area C: Waive one EDR (CEEP) course from the left column (3 cr.). Take one racial issues course from the left column (3 cr.). Options: CMTY 111/ 470; HIST 109; ETHS 201/205/210; SOC 268. Take HURL 497 (3 cr.)—double count in Professional Education Core. In addition, all students must complete PESS (1 cr.).

¹Students are to choose two classes in American Literature. These include one early American Literature (ENGL 310 or 311) and one late American Literature (ENGL 312 or 313).

²Three classes in British Literature are required. These include Shakespeare (ENGL 323), early British Literature (ENGL 321, 322, or 325), and late British Literature (ENGL 326, 327, or 328).

³Students may choose one of the following theory/practice courses: ENGL 300, 402/502, 431/531, 464/564, 465/565, 466/566. [Note that ENGL 361 is a prerequisite for some of these offerings.]

⁴Students may choose one of the following upper division writing courses: ENGL 331, 332, 333, or 353.
