First Year (30 credits)

ENG 191	Area A general education elective
CMST 192	Area B general education elective (lab)
CMTY 195 (or other offering of 195)	Area C general education elective
PHIL 194	Area A or B general education elective
CMTY 200 (Area C general education)	Area A or B general education elective

Note: Student may declare the CD major after completing CMTY 200 with a grade of B- or higher and maintaining an overall GPA of at least 2.55.

Second Year (31 credits)

CMTY 333	Area C general education elective
CMTY 350	Area A or B general education elective
CMTY 363, 367, or 369	PESS 122 (1 credit)
GEOG 394	Elective (3 classes)
MATH or STAT 193	

Note: A minor to accompany the CD major is **not** required. However, the student may decide to apply his/her 26 credits of electives towards a minor if they choose. Alternatively, they can take additional classes in CD beyond the minimum requirements and/or take other classes on campus that interest them.

Third Year (30 credits)

CMTY 363, 367, 369, or 464 (2 classes)
CMTY 422, 428, 450, or 451 (2 classes)
CMTY 470 or 475 or GERO 405
CD Major Elective (from approved list)
GERO 411 or 435
Electives (3 classes)

Fourth Year (30 credits)

CMTY 422, 428, 450, or 451 (1 class)
CD Applied Elective (from approved list)
Electives (4 classes)
CMTY 493 (Internship) – 9 credits (last semester)
CMTY 494 (last semester)

General Notes:

- By taking at least 3 credits one summer, the student can reduce the total credits during the 4th year, which is advantageous due to demands of internship
- Students must take 3 diversity classes, one of which can be CMTY 470
- All CD majors meet the SCSU requirement for upper division credits
- Working closely with your CD advisor is highly recommended throughout
