**Notes:**

1. For a student to earn a B.S. degree and social studies licensure for grades 5-12 in 128 semester credits, it will normally be necessary for the student to complete 15 to 18 credits for 7 semesters and 12 credits in the student teaching semester.
2. Three of the courses selected for AREAS A, B, & C in General Education must be Diversity courses. One of these must be a Racial Issues course taken in the first year at SCSU.
3. Select three General Education courses from AREA A and two from AREA B OR two from AREA A and three from AREA B. For the AREA from which two courses are selected, the courses must come from the ones listed in the left hand column.

4. A placement test administered by the Department of Mathematics is required to determine readiness for STAT/MATH 193. Contact the Math Department at 320-308-3011.
5. STAT 193 is recommended rather than MATH 193.
6. HIST 140 and 141 may be taken in any order, ie., 140 is not a prerequisite for 141.
7. HIST 210 and 211 may be taken in any order, ie., 210 is not a prerequisite for 211.
8. HURL 498 MUST be taken with HURL 497.
9. PSY 240, ED 300, HLTH 301, CEEP 361, HURL 497/498, and IM 422 must be completed before taking ED 421, 431, & 441.
