**Notes:**

1. For a student to earn a B.S. degree and social studies licensure for grades 5-12 in 128 semester credits, it will normally be necessary for the student to complete 15 to 18 credits for 7 semesters and 12 credits in the student teaching semester.
2. Three of the courses selected for AREAS A, B, & C in General Education must be Diversity courses. One of these must be a Racial Issues course taken in the first year at SCSU.
3. Select three General Education courses from AREA A and two from AREA B OR two from AREA A and three from AREA B. For the AREA from which two courses are selected, the courses must

7. HURL 498 MUST be taken with HURL 497.
8. PSY 240, ED 300, HLTH 301, CEEP 361, HURL 497/498, and IM 422 must be completed before taking ED 421, 431, & 441.
